The census at the time of the survey was 102. The sample size was five. There were three complaints investigated. Unsubstantiated: 1. Complaint #NV00071972 could not be substantiated. No regulatory deficiencies could be identified. 2. Complaint #NV00072288 could not be substantiated. No regulatory deficiencies could be identified. 3. Complaint #NV00072347 could not be substantiated. No regulatory deficiencies could be identified. The investigation of Complaints included: Observation of grooming and physical appearance for residents, staffing levels in the facility, staff interacting with residents, water and juices being offered, meal observation with clean cutlery in the dining room and resident rooms, staff answering call lights, and a tour of the facility. Interviews were conducted with residents, Caregivers, The Resident Service Coordinator, and the Administrator. Record Review of five records, which included the resident of concern. Document Review included facility policy and procedures, and grievance logs.
