ORDER OF COMPLIANCE

On this date, Petitioner's Petition for an Order of Compliance was considered by the Board, along with evidence submitted by the Petitioner. Petitioner has proven to the satisfaction of this Board that the conditions of the November 22, 2022 Consent Order (Order) have been met. The Order placed Petitioner's license (A.C.L.F., Lic. No. 304) on probation no longer than twelve (12) months, assessed civil monetary penalties in the amount of one thousand five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), and provide training to office staff on medication administration and safety.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that Petitioner is relieved from any further responsibilities under the November 22, 2022 Consent Order. The probation of the assisted care living facility license is lifted, and the license is restored to active, unencumbered status.
