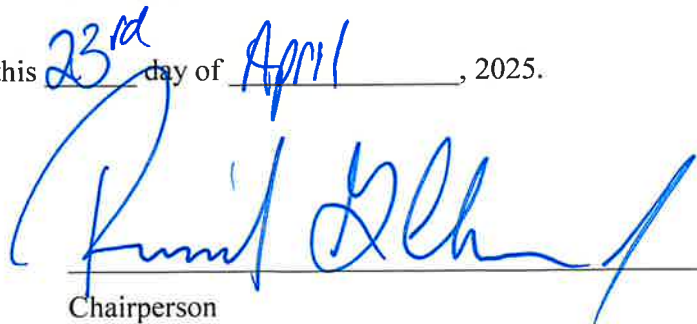

ORDER OF COMPLIANCE

On this date, Respondent's Petition for an Order of Compliance was considered by the Commission, along with evidence submitted by the Petitioner. Petitioner has proven to the satisfaction of this Commission that the conditions of the June 5, 2024, Consent Order have been met. See Attachment 1. The Order placed Petitioner's license (Assisted Care Living Facility, Lic. No. 432) on probation for six (6) months and assessed civil monetary penalties in the amount of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.00).

Therefore, it is ORDERED that Petitioner is relieved from any further responsibilities under the June 5, 2024, Consent Order. The probation of the Assisted Care Living Facility license is lifted, and the license is restored to active, unencumbered status.
