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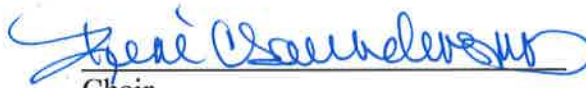
ORDER OF COMPLIANCE

This cause came on to be heard on the 3rd day of June, 2020, upon the Petition for Order of Compliance filed by Petitioner, Carriage Court of Memphis, pursuant to a Consent Order issued by the Board on 5th day of June, 2019 which placed Petitioner's license to operate as an assisted living on probation for no less than six (6) months. During the period of probation, Petitioner was required to submit an acceptable plan of correction within thirty (30) days. Further, during the six (6) month period of probation, any new serious violation affecting the health, safety, and welfare of residents within the facility shall result in a suspension of admissions pending a prompt hearing by the Board.

Contingent on the successful passage of the revisit survey, the Board finds that Petitioner has satisfactorily complied with the requirements of the June 2019 Consent Order and probation of Petitioner's license shall be lifted.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** that the probation of Petitioner's license is hereby lifted and Petitioner's license is returned to an unencumbered status.
