WAC 388-76-10475 Medication Log. The adult family home must:

(1) Keep an up-to-date daily medication log for each resident except for residents assessed as medication independent with self-administration.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observations, interviews and record reviews, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to maintain an up-to-date daily medication log for each resident who required assistance with administering medications for 1 of 2 (Resident 6) residents, which placed Resident 6 at risk of having an incorrect medication log.

During an interview on 09/11/2025 at 11:45AM, the Lead Caregiver stated that Resident 6 required staff to assist with administering medications.

Review of Resident 6's pharmacy Electronic Medication Administration Record (EMAR) showed Resident 6 had an order for Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen 10-325mg tablet (a combination medication used to relieve moderate severe pain), to be administered twice daily, once at 8:00AM and once at 9:00PM. The EMAR showed the following:

-The 8:00AM dose of Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen was not administered on 09/01/2025 and 09/06/2025.

-The 9:00PM dose of Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen was not administered on 09/01/2025 to 09/10/2025.

Review of the "exceptions" page of the EMAR showed the Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen was not administered to the resident on these dates because the medication was "WITHHELD PER DR/RN ORDERS".

On 09/11/2025 at 12:50PM, observations of Resident 6's medication supply showed that

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the Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen was not included in Resident 6's medications on hand at the AFH.

Review of Resident 6's "Office Visit Note" dated 09/02/2025, showed the Nurse Practitioner documented that the resident had been out of Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen for "some time" and planned to discontinue the medication as the resident's pain was being managed with another medication.

During an interview on 09/11/2025 at 1:00PM, Caregiver A stated that the medication was not administered because the doctor put a hold on the order during the most recent visit. Caregiver B stated that they and the other staff member who administered medications were aware of the doctor's direction but must have marked the EMAR in error as the medication is no longer available in the resident's medication supply.

During an interview on 09/11/2025 at 3:05PM, the Lead Caregiver stated that staff were aware of the doctor's directions to hold the medication and staff had not been administering the medication as it was not included in Resident 6's available medications and the staff must have documented on the EMAR in error.

I hereby certify that I have reviewed this report and have taken or will take active measures to correct this deficiency. By taking this action, Maple Adult Family Home is or will be in compliance with this law and / or regulation on (Date) 09/23/2025
