Based on observation and interview, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to ensure toxic cleaning supplies were in locked storage. This failure placed 6 of 8 residents (Residents 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6) at risk of accidental illness or injury.

Findings included...

Observation, on 03/26/2025 at 1:45 PM, showed Resident 2 ambulating independently to their bedroom with a walker.

Observation during the environmental tour, on 03/26/2025 at 11:52 AM, showed the laundry room door was open and contained no form of lock to secure the room.

Observation, on 03/26/2025 at 10:41 AM, showed cleaning chemicals (Clorox wipes with bleach, Windex, Shout, Lysol spray, pledge spray, and laundry detergent) being stored in a closet within the laundry room. The closet within the laundry room was observed to have no form of lock either.

Interview, on 03/26/2025 at 12:00 PM, the Provider, Staff A stated that they were aware toxic cleaning supplies needed to be kept in a locked storage. Staff A stated that they did not know why toxic substances were being kept in the laundry room closet.
