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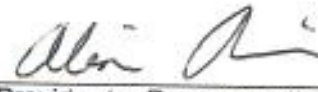

WAC 388-112A-0080 Who is required to complete the seventy-hour long-term care worker basic training and by when? The following individuals must complete the seventy-hour long-term care worker basic training unless exempt as described in WAC 388-112A-0090 : Adult family homes.

(3) Long-term care workers in adult family homes within one hundred twenty days of date of hire. Long-term care workers must not provide personal care without direct supervision until they have completed the seventy-hour long-term care worker basic training. Assisted living facilities.

WAC 388-76-10135 Qualifications Caregiver. The adult family home must ensure each caregiver has the following minimum qualifications:

(4) Has completed the training requirements in effect on the date the caregiver was hired, including the requirements applicable to the caregiver under chapter 388-112A WAC;

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on interview and record review, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to ensure that 1 of 6 staff (Staff D, Caregiver) who provided care to residents completed the seventy-hour basic training within one hundred twenty days of their hire date. This failure placed all Residents (Residents 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6) at risk for receiving care from an unqualified caregiver.

Findings Included...

Record review of the AFH's Employee Orientation Checklist showed that Staff D was hired by the AFH on 09/08/2025 as a caregiver. Record review of Staff D's personnel records showed Staff D had no training certificate for completion of seventy-hour long-term care worker basic training from a DSHS approved trainer. Staff D was thirty-seven days overdue for completing the basic training.

During an interview, on 02/12/2026 at 3:15 PM, Staff A, Entity Representative/Resident Manager, stated that Staff D had not worked alone since they were hired. Staff A stated that they do not have a training certificate for seventy-hour long-term care worker basic training for Staff D.

During an interview, on 02/12/2026 at 3:16 PM, Staff D stated that they had not completed the seventy-hour long-term care worker basic training yet. Staff D stated that they needed to sign up for the classes.

I hereby certify that I have reviewed this report and have taken or will take active measures to correct this deficiency. By taking this action, MARI'S HOME CARE INC is or will be in compliance with this law and / or regulation on (Date) 2-28-26.
