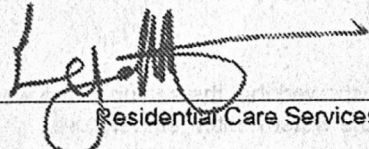

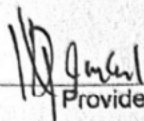

WAC 388-76-10750 Safety and maintenance. The adult family home must:

(6) Ensure hot water temperature is at least one hundred five degrees and does not exceed one hundred twenty degrees Fahrenheit at all fixtures used by or accessible to residents, such as:

(c) Sinks;

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation and interview, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to ensure the water temperature in 2 of 2 bathrooms used by residents did not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit. This placed all five ambulatory residents (Residents 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5) at risk from scalding burns.

Findings included...

Observation, on 07/24/2024 at 8:05 AM, showed the home was a two-level home. Resident 2 lived on the [REDACTED] and Residents 1, 3, 4 and 5 lived on the [REDACTED] of the home. Observation showed all five residents were on the lower level of the home at the dining table eating breakfast.

Observation, on 07/24/2024 at 10:45 AM and throughout the visit, showed all five residents ambulated independently in the home and they used bathrooms independently. There was a bathroom with showers on each level of the home. The water temperature in the sink of the main bathroom and shower on the lower level (bathroom #1), used by all residents, was 127.5 degrees Fahrenheit. The water in the sink on the upper-level bathroom (bathroom #2), used by all ambulatory residents, was hot to touch and steaming. It measured 128.8.3 degrees Fahrenheit.

In an interview on 7/24/2024 at 10:49 AM, Staff A, Provider stated that the home replaced the water heater 3 days prior to visit.

Observation of the water heater on 7/24/2024 at 11:15 AM showed that the setting of the water heater temperature was set at "very hot." Staff A adjusted the water heater temperature.

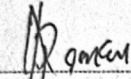
