As a result of the on-site visit(s), the department found that you are not in compliance with the licensing laws and regulations as stated in the cited deficiencies in the enclosed report.

WAC 388-76-10025 License annual fee.

- (1) The adult family home must pay the license fee that is established in the state's operating budget, as described in RCW 70.128.060 .
- (2) Each year, the home's annual license fee is due during the same month in which the home was initially licensed. For example, if the home was licensed in June, 2010, then the annual licensing fee will be due in June of each year.
- (3) The home must ensure that the department receives the annual license fee when it is due.
- (4) If the home does not pay the fee when it is due, the department will impose remedies.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation, interview and record review, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to ensure the Department received the annual license fee when it was due. This failure placed 5 of 5 residents (Resident 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5) at risk of living in a home that had not paid their annual licensing fee.

Findings included...

Observation, on 04/24/2024 at 12:45 PM, showed there were five residents who resided in the AFH.

Record review, on 04/24/2024 at 2:30 PM, of the Department's electronic Secure Tracking and Reporting System, showed the AFH had an overdue annual license fee of \$1350.00 that was due 02/11/2024.

In an interview, on 04/24/2024 at 1:18 PM, Staff A (Entity Representative) stated that they did not pay the AFH's annual \$1350.00 license fee that was due 02/11/2024 because they did not see a bill in the mail for it.
