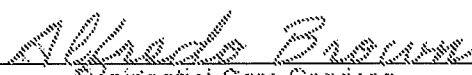

WAC 388-76-10280 Tuberculosis One test. The adult family home is only required to have a person take one test if the person has any of the following:

(2) A documented negative result from one skin or blood test in the previous twelve months.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on record review and interview, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to have ensure that 1 of 3 staff (Staff B) had one documented tuberculosis (TB) skin or blood test in place after staff presented with a documented negative 2-step skin test in the previous twelve months. This failure placed 3 of 3 residents (Resident 1, 2, and 3) at risk of contracting a communicable disease.

Findings included...

Record review showed Staff B, Caregiver, was hired on 11/15/2024. Staff B's personnel file had a one-step TST with a negative result of 0 millimeters read on 03/26/2024. Staff B had a 2nd step TST with a negative result of 0 millimeters read on 04/16/2024. Staff B had a TB Screening Form dated 11/15/2024 that was signed and dated by a registered nurse on 10/14/2024. No additional TB test records for 2024 were provided.

During an interview on 01/29/2025 at 4:51 PM, Staff A stated that upon hire, the AFH asked Staff B to complete a 1-step test, but they declined, stating that they did not want to do unnecessary testing since they had already completed a 2-step test a few months ago before joining their AFH. The AFH ended up doing the TB Screening signs and symptoms form instead. Staff A stated that they tried explaining to Staff B that they needed to do a new test, but Staff B stated that they were told by their previous employer that they only needed to do TB testing once a year, even if they changed jobs.

Plan of Correction for Mindful Senior Care.

I am writing to address the citation received on February 3, 2025, concerning tuberculosis testing at Mindful Senior Care. We acknowledge the importance of compliance with WAC 388-76-10280 and have taken immediate action to rectify the situation.

Plan of Correction:

1. Corrective Action Taken:

- On January 27, 2025, Caregiver B completed the Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) blood test for tuberculosis.
- The test results were received on January 29, 2025, confirming that Caregiver B tested negative for tuberculosis.

2. Preventive Measures:

- Going forward, all staff at Mindful Senior Care will undergo timely tuberculosis testing in accordance with tuberculosis WAC's 388-76.
- We have updated our training and onboarding procedures to ensure that all new caregivers are aware of the tuberculosis testing requirements.
- Our administrative team will maintain accurate records of all tuberculosis testing to ensure ongoing compliance.

We take this citation seriously and are committed to maintaining the highest standards of care and compliance at Mindful Senior Care. We appreciate your guidance and oversight in helping us provide a safe and healthy environment for our residents and staff.
