**WAC 388-76-10895 Emergency evacuation drills Frequency and participation.**

(3) The home must respect the resident's right to refuse to participate in emergency evacuation drills. However, the home must still demonstrate the ability to safely evacuate all residents doing the following:

- (a) Documenting the resident's wish to refuse to participate in the negotiated care plan;
- (b) Providing an estimate of the amount of time it would take to evacuate the resident and how they calculated this estimate in the negotiated care plan;
- (c) Adding the estimated time to the time recorded on the emergency evacuation drill log after each drill to ensure the length of time to evacuate does not exceed five minutes; and

**This requirement was not met as evidenced by:**

Based on record review, observation, and interview, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to document residents' wish to refuse participation in evacuation drills and the estimated time it would take to evacuate them in their Negotiated Care Plan (NCP) for 2 of 2 residents (Resident 1 and 2). This placed Resident 1 and 2 at risk of being unprepared in the event of an emergency.

Findings included...

Review of evacuation logs dated 06/09/2024 to 06/04/2025, showed that Resident 1 refused to participate in the evacuation drills on 06/09/2024, 10/07/2024, 12/09/2024, 2/07/2025 and 06/04/2025 and Resident 2 refused to participate in the evacuation drills

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on 06/09/2024, 12/09/2024 and 06/04/2025.

On 06/11/2025 at 9:25 AM, during an interview, Staff A, Provider, stated that Resident 1 and 2 required assistance for evacuation.

Review of Resident 1's NCP dated 01/30/2025 showed no documentation in the NCP reflecting the Resident's wish to refuse to participate in the evacuation drills.

Review of Resident 2's NCP dated 07/21/2024, showed no documentation in the NCP reflecting the Resident's wish to refuse to participate in the evacuation drills.

On 06/11/2025 at 11:10 AM, during an interview, Staff A stated that Residents 1 and 2 sometimes refuse to participate in the evacuation drills but they had not realized it had to be documented in their NCPs.

I hereby certify that I have reviewed this report and have taken or will take active measures to correct this deficiency. By taking this action, Joyful Haven AFH LLC is or will be in compliance with this law and / or regulation on (Date)\_\_\_\_\_.
