WAC 388-76-10165 Background checks Washington state name and date of birth background check Valid for two years National fingerprint background check Valid indefinitely.

(1) A Washington state name and date of birth background check is valid for two years from the initial date it is conducted. The adult family home must ensure:

(a) A new DSHS background authorization form is submitted to the department's background check central unit every two years for each individual listed in WAC 388-76-10161 ;

(b) There is a valid Washington state background check for all individuals listed in WAC 388-76-10161 .

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on interview and record review, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to complete a Washington State Name and Date of Birth background check (BGC) on 1 of 3 staff members, (Staff B. caregiver). This failure placed 5 of 5 residents at risk of receiving care and services from someone who may have a disqualifying criminal background.

Findings included...

Observation on 05/22/2025 at 12:20 PM, showed Staff B, Caregiver, was providing care and services to five residents.

Review of AFH records showed Staff B was hired on 06/23/2023. Review of the AFH's BGCs, showed Staff B. had a BGC done on 03/14/2023. This BGC expired on 03/14/2025.

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In an interview, on 05/22/2025 at 1:05 PM, Staff A, Entity Representative, stated that they were unaware Staff B's BGC was not current. Staff B stated they would submit a new BGC as soon as they could.

Review of email received on 05/23/2025, showed Staff B's BGC updated on 05/23/2025 after the regulator had left the AFH.
